

Things to know about **Pangbourne Defibrillators...**

Pangbourne has five automated external defibrillators (AED) for public use when someone may be having a heart attack (cardiac arrest)

Your first action must be to **PHONE 999 AND ASK FOR AN AMBULANCE TO ATTEND**

The operator will provide an access code for the cabinet
