Meadowside Road, Meadow Lane (part), Short Street & Horseshoe Road, Pangbourne Essential Carriageway Resurfacing

I am writing to inform you that following the recent kerbing work West Berkshire Council's contractor Volker Highways Ltd., will be undertaking essential resurfacing works in all roads listed above from **Monday 25 October to Friday 5 November 2021 between 7.30am to 5.00pm** weekdays as shown on the enclosed plan. Works are programmed to start in Meadowside Road, Meadow Lane (part), and progress in to Short Street then Horseshoe Road. Emergency vehicles will be given access under site staff supervision.

The proposed programme is highlighted on the attached plan and information boards will be erected on site. While these works are weather dependent, every effort will be made to complete these works as per the programme.

Should it be necessary to revise the programme, the information boards on site will be updated accordingly. Temporary suspension of on street parking will be necessary as the works progress, however, if you subscribe to the on street parking permit scheme you can park in any P1 zone within Pangbourne. Please do **NOT** leave any vehicle parked on the public highway within coned off works areas or No Parking cones. Failure to do so may result in damage to your vehicle or injury to the workforce.


