This is the health and safety policy statement of:

Our health and safety policy is to:

- provide clear instructions and information, and adequate training, to ensure employees
- are competent to do their work
- provide personal protective equipment
- consult with our employees on matters affecting their health and safety
- provide and maintain safe plant and equipment
- ensure safe handling and use of substances
- maintain safe and healthy working conditions
- implement emergency procedures, including evacuation in case of fire or other
- significant incident
- review and revise this policy regularly

1 Overall and final responsibility for health and safety:

2 Day-to-day responsibility for ensuring this policy is put into practice:

Becky Elkin, Clerk to the Parish Council

3 To ensure health and safety standards are maintained/improved, the following people have responsibility in the following areas:

Peter Maclver and Becky Elkin – safety, risk assessments, consulting employees, accidents, first aid and work-related ill health Becky Elkin – monitoring, accident and ill-health investigation, emergency procedures, fire and evacuation Peter Maclver – maintaining equipment, information, instruction and supervision, training

- 4 All employees should:
- co-operate with supervisors and managers on health and safety matters;
- take reasonable care of their own health and safety; and
- report all health and safety concerns to an appropriate person (as detailed above).



Part 3: Arrangements for health and safety

Risk assessment

- We will complete relevant risk assessments and take action.
- We will review risk assessments when working habits or conditions change.

Training

- We will give staff health and safety induction and provide appropriate training.
- We will provide personal protective equipment.
- We will make sure suitable arrangements are in place for employees who work remotely.

Consultation

We will consult staff routinely on health and safety matters as they arise and formally when we review health and safety.

Evacuation

- We will make sure escape routes are well signed and kept clear at all times.
- Evacuation plans are tested from time to time and updated if necessary.
